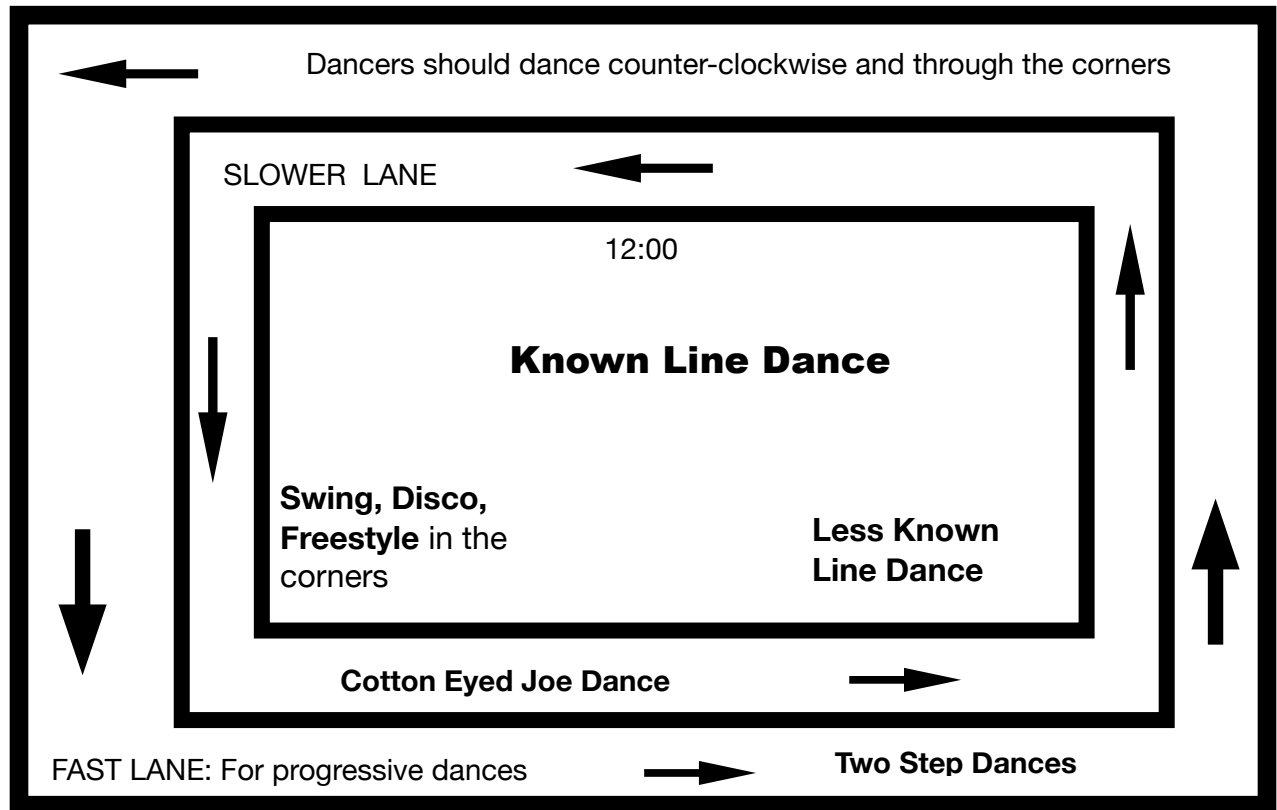


DANCE FLOOR ETIQUETTE



- If you are not dancing, don't stand on the dance floor. Move near a wall to figure out a dance or film a dance.
- Move your conversation from the dance floor to a nearby wall.
- No food or drinks on the dance floor. If you spill on the floor wipe it up immediately.
- If you bump into someone, smile and apologize.
- Be helpful to visitors and newcomers.
- Those dancing around the outside lane have the right of way, don't block their progress
- If the floor is crowded take smaller steps to avoid collisions.
- Do not use your cellphone on the dance floor.
- Leave and enter the dance floor using the nearest exit and walk around the outside to return to your table.
- Do not cut through the dance floor while a dance is in progress.
- If you arrive to the dance floor while a dance is in progress, take the available spot nearest an entrance to the dance floor.
- No road rage on the dance floor. If you see someone breaking the rules, let it go.
- Clap to let the DJ/Instructor know you liked the dance.
